Adding Fractions

$$\frac{1}{5} + \frac{9}{16} = \frac{61}{80}$$

$$\frac{2}{5} + \frac{1}{4} = \frac{13}{20}$$

$$\frac{4}{7} + \frac{2}{11} = \frac{58}{77}$$

$$\frac{1}{6} + \frac{1}{5} = \frac{11}{30}$$

$$\frac{7}{8} + \frac{2}{7} = \frac{65}{56}$$

$$\frac{6}{7} + \frac{3}{8} = \frac{69}{56}$$
